Dear Denver Figure Skating Club Skating Member,

With a new membership year, we are sending you information regarding the Junior and Adult Scholarship Awards. Denver Figure Skating Club offers scholarships in the form of money or coupons toward memberships to all skating members.

The award amounts are based the freeskate or dance level as of May 15, 2008 for both Junior and Adult skaters. There is also a separate Dance Scholarship in addition to the Junior and Adult skater awards. See attached for the award levels and amounts for the 2007-2008 membership year.

In order to be eligible for a scholarship award, you must:

- 1) Be a full member of Denver Figure Skating Club for at least one year or renew membership by 8/1/2007.
- 2) Be actively testing or competing,
- 3) Volunteer at least 10 hours during the membership year (July 1-June 30) for each skater member. It is recommended that at least 5 hours of volunteer time be done at Denver Invitational as this is the club's major fundraiser and many volunteers are needed to make this a success.
- 4) Complete a volunteer form and submit by the due date for each skating member eligible for a scholarship.

A separate competition award(s) is available for individuals or teams who qualify for Sectionals or Nationals. These awards are determined on a case by case basis and require an additional 10 hours of volunteer time in order to be eligible.

Volunteer opportunities consist of Colorado Championships (8/2007), Keystone Ice Show (12/2007), Denver Invitational (3/2008), High School Competition (4/2008), Club Ice Show at South Suburban (5/2008), Test Sessions (dates varies), Club Ice (dates varies), other opportunities throughout the year include newsletter, web site liaison, phone calls, mailings, etc.

The amount of money awarded is based on income for the 2007-2008 membership year with the exception of the Dance Scholarship. The Dance Scholarship money has been made available by an endowment left to Denver Figure Skating Club to use from Margaret Kaflich, a long time member of Denver Figure Skating Club. Denver Figure Skating Club continues to recognize all of the hard work our skaters put into representing their club.

Enclosed with this letter is your volunteer form for the 2007-2008 membership year. This form must be submitted by May 15, 2008 in order to receive a scholarship.

We are looking forward to a great year and continue to recognize the outstanding dedication that all of our members contribute to Denver Figure Skating Club.
